

Private Vehicle Use to Transport Students

Rationale:

The use of private vehicles to transport students during school hours will be minimised. However, it is recognised that, at times, staff members and parents are required to use their own private vehicle for this purpose.

Aims:

To ensure any use of private vehicles for the purpose of transporting students complies with Department of Education and Early Childhood Development requirements.

Implementation:

- 1. There are times when staff and parents may be requested to use their own private vehicles to transport students to a venue. These times may include a second vehicle for school camps, transporting staff or students to or from events, etc
- 2. Prior approval must be sought from the principal or the principal's representative before a private vehicle is used to transport students.
- 3. When establishing such routines or arrangements, it must be understood that the principal does not have the authority to direct staff to use their own private vehicles.
- 4. When a private vehicle is used to transport students, the parent/guardian of each student must be advised of the name of the driver/s and requested to provide written consent for their child to travel in a vehicle(s) driven by the named driver(s).
- 5. The principal must ensure that any vehicle used for the transport of students is currently registered and that the driver holds a valid driver's licence.
- 6. Any vehicle used in connection with the school program must have a comprehensive insurance policy.
- 7. Prior to using the vehicle to transport students, a *Private Vehicle Transportation Form* will be completed and accompanied by a copy of a current driver's licence, and a copy of the vehicle's comprehensive insurance policy as detailed above. (See Appendix 1).
- 8. All appropriate alternative modes of travel must be sought prior to an individual using their own vehicle.
- 9. A parent/guardian who transports students, other than their own children, to an excursion is required to submit to the school office a current Working with Children Check.

Evaluation

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's Review cycle.

Appendix 1: Private Vehicle Transportation

This form is to be used to request approval to use a private vehicle to transport students. Information collected on this form is required to determine the entitlement and the personal information provided will be kept secure against unauthorised use or disclosure.

A copy of the current driver's licence and the comprehensive insurance policy will accompany this form. The vehicle registration will be confirmed by a St. Richard's staff member.
